Security Council Extends UN presence in Timor-Leste until end of 2012

23 February 2012 the Security Council today extended until the end of 2012 the mandate of the United Nations peacekeeping mission in Timor-Leste so that it can continue to help promote peace, stability and development in what is expected to be a very eventful year for the country.

Until its expected departure on December 31, the UN Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste (UNMIT) will assist with tasks such as institutional development and capacity– building of the national police , known as the PNTL, as well as provide electoral assistance. H.E.Dr. Francisco Xavier do Amaral East Timor Founding father 1937-2012



Francisco Xavier do Amaral, passed away in the morning of Tuesday, March 6, 2012 from natural causes in hospital Guido Valadares in Dili, Timor-Leste. He was the Father Founding of Independence and the first President of Timor-Leste. He declared Unilateral Independence on the 28th of November 1975, after the decolonization from Portugal.

On March 7, 2012, the body of Dr. Amaral left his residency and passed through the National Parliament and thence to the Hall of the Palacio do President.

The Funeral took place on March 8, 2012 in the Cemetery Garden of Heros , Metinaro, Dili. Dr. Amaral, 75 yrs. Old was also a candidate for the March 17th Presidential Election for the Timorese Social Democratic Association (ASDT). For the Government's Press release click <u>here</u>.
